<p>Breast (CA15.3) – Female Only - Cancer-Antigen 15.3 is used to monitor breast cancer.</p>	<p>Stomach/Colon (CEA) - Carcinoembryonic Antigen is a type of molecular protein, which can be found in many different cells in our body. A rise in CEA level indicates progression or recurrence of the cancer.</p>
<p>Liver (AFP) - Alpha-Fetoprotein is a protein to screen for liver cancer.</p>	
<p>Nose & Throat (EBV) - Epstein-Barr Virus is a common virus, which can be linked to several rare cancers; Hodgkin Lymphoma, Nasopharyngeal carcinoma etc.</p>	<p>Pancreas (CA19.9) - This test screen for Pancreatic cancer. Pancreas produce enzymes to digest food, as well as insulin to regular blood sugar.</p>
<p>Ovarian (CA125) – Female Only - CA125 is a protein found in women. Women with Ovarian Cancer have relatively high level of CA125 in their blood stream.</p>	<p>Prostate (PSA) – Male Only - Prostate-Specific Antigen is a protein produced by cells of the prostate gland and is to screen for prostate enlargement and disorders.</p>

<p>Germ Cell (Beta HCG) - Elevation of Beta Human Chorionic Gonadotropin level indicates abnormalities in Uterus (Female) or Testicular (Male).</p>	<p>Stomach Ulcer (Helicobacter Pylori) - Helicobacter Pylori is a bacterium in the stomach. This bacterium causes chronic inflammation which may lead to stomach ulcers & gastritis.</p>
<p>C-Reactive Protein (HSCRIP) - High Sensitive C-Reactive Protein is to measure the level of inflammation in the body. This may lead to several heart-related conditions such as; Heart Attack, Stroke, Peripheral Arterial Disease.</p>	<p>Testosterone - This is the principal male sex hormone that plays key roles such as enhanced libido, energy, immune function and protection against bone loss. Testosterone levels decline gradually with men.</p>
